

Don't Post Signs on Utility Poles

A utility pole is no place to advertise your next yard sale.

Stapling or nailing papers to a utility pole puts line crews in peril when the sharp, protruding objects tear their gloves and protective clothing or catch on boots, causing climbers to slip.

Utility poles have a single purpose: to support the lines that bring electricity, cable TV and telephone service to your home. They weren't meant as posts for advertising.

Post your notices on community bulletin boards instead, and keep utility poles safe for the crews who keep the lights on in our town.
