1. Resolution authorizing 2018-2030 fixed volume energy supply

Mr. Glenn White from MSCPA presented an update on Endicott retirement and Michigan energy legistration. He also reviewed Hillsdale's energy needs and resources and presented a power supply study. The retirement of Endicott opens up the opportunity to rebalance the remaining needs for each of our members through the use of market purchases and purchase power agreements (PPA's). Recommendation the board authorize the purchase of a total of 25 MW, to be allocated hourly to each member based on their respective needs, with the 25 MW split up into three different PPA's as follows:

- 1) 10MW 5x16 for 2018-2020
- 2) 1-MW 5x16 for 2018-2025
- 3) 5MW 5x16 for 2018-2030

By layering in the contracts, we will have an opportunity to adjust in the future to accommodate for changes in loads or other resource opportunities.
