"I started with the City of Hillsdale on August 5, 1980. My first position was working for the City Manager at the time and managing all of the employee personnel functions. When I began, offices were then on the 2nd floor where the current elevator is located.

As years went by, the personnel functions expanded and changed. I then became Human Resources Director, but continued to work with the City Manager; assisting and doing research.

DAWN THEATER UPDATE



In May of 2019, the City was awarded a \$1.4 Million grant to rehabilitate the Dawn Theater. The project began in July 2019 with completion scheduled by the Fall of 2020. The Dawn Theater originally opened its doors to the public on September 5, 1919. We hope to have a celebration of the project at the 100 year anniversary of the Dawn Theater's grand opening on September 5, 2019.

PLANNING AND ZONING

REDEVELOPMENT READY COMMUNITIES PROGRAM

The City was accepted in the Redevelopment Ready Communities Program (RRC) in the Spring of 2014. The program was created by the Michigan Economic Development Corporation (MEDC) to help communities that were struggling economically to become more attractive to developers. The program addresses multiple aspects of a community: zoning ordinances, master planning, branding, site development, and other items. MEDC provides resources and consultants to help with the various processes. In June of 2019, the City finally achieved its certification. The state will now list the City of Hillsdale as a community that is ready and welcoming to developers from within and without the State.
